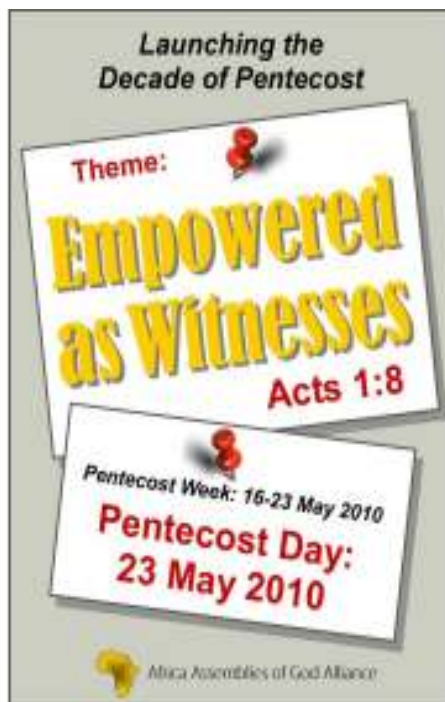
### River State Revival
