Our African Pastors Need Your Prayers

During the **Decade of Pentecost** (2010-2020) the Africa Assemblies of God is believing God for 10 million new believers to be baptized in the Holy Spirit and mobilized as Spirit-empowered witnesses, church planters, and missionaries. Our more than 60,000 AG pastors across the continent are key to the success of this initiative. If these men and women will frequently teach and preach on the message of Pentecost, and will faithfully challenge their people to be empowered by the Spirit, revival will come. If, however, they neglect the message—or somehow miss Jesus' mandate of Acts 1:8—all will be for naught. This month we will once again pray for these pastors. We will pray that God will pour out His Spirit on them, and that they will faithfully and boldly proclaim Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit. —Denny Miller, AIA Director

Pray for Africa's Pastors:

- Pray that God will powerfully fill and re-fill each of our 60,000 pastors in Africa with the Holy Spirit, and that they will faithfully and effectively proclaim the life-giving message of Christ to those around them.
- Pray that these pastors will boldly lead their congregations into authentic Pentecostal experience and practice.
- Pray for our pastors as they prepare to preach on the baptism in the Holy Spirit and the Great Commission on the Day of Pentecost—2011 (June 12). (Note: The theme for the day is "Proclaiming Christ in the Spirit's Power—Acts 4:31." On that day every AG pastor in Africa is encouraged to preach a message on the baptism in the Holy Spirit and the Great Commission and then pray with their people to be filled with the Spirit.)
- Pray for the tens of thousands of Spirit-filled laymen and laywomen who are faithfully leading many of our churches throughout Africa. Pray that God will anoint, enable, and use them.

Africa's Unreached Ethne: *The Vai of Liberia and Sierra Leone*



The Assemblies of God, Liberia, have committed themselves to reaching nine least reached tribal groups in Liberia during the Decade of Pentecost. One of those groups is the Via of northwestern Liberia and eastern Sierra Leone. The Vai are predominantly farmers, although they are also known as skilled carpenters, weavers, and tailors. Mostly Muslim, the Vai are, nevertheless, very superstitious and some practice witchcraft. They consider themselves to be surrounded by powerful spirits that can change into living creatures or objects. Only a few of the Vai have committed their lives to Christ. Pray that God will open the hearts of the Vai people as the AG Liberia seeks to reach them with the gospel.
