### Africa's Unreached Ethne: *The Tukolor of Senegal*

The Tukolor homeland is divided by the Senegal River, with 242,000 living in Mauritania and 939,000 in Senegal. Every village and town has a mosque with two tall minarets on the front and two short ones at the back. Most of them are well-built concrete buildings and appear to have been constructed with foreign money. To our knowledge there is no open gospel witness among the Tukolor of Senegal. The absence of any church or known Christian among these hospitable people emphasizes their lost condition. They are truly unreached. A research team's recent visit gives hope for an outreach to them in the near future.
