

# **FULL GOSPEL MISSION, CAMEROON**

## **DECADE OF PENTECOST DECLARATION**

9 March 2013, Yaoundé, Cameroon

**Wherefore** the Lord God has commissioned the Church to fulfill His mission by evangelizing people from all nations, tribes, languages and peoples;

**Wherefore** the Lord has also commanded the Church to fulfill the mission of God only through the power of the Holy Spirit;

**Wherefore** the Full Gospel Mission of Cameroon was founded and constituted to fulfill the missional desires of God,

**Having received** the challenge during the Acts 1: 8 Conference held at the Tsinga Church in Yaoundé, 5-9 March 2013, We, the Leaders, Pastors, and Delegates, who are the representative of the Full Gospel Mission of Cameroon covenant ourselves with the Lord to see that the following goals are achieved during the Decade of Pentecost:

1. Grow from 126,000 to 1,200,000 Spirit-baptized members (and at least 85% baptized).
2. Have 2000 more Churches planted by the end of the decade.
3. Send and support 10 fully supported international and 40 bi-vocational missionaries.
4. Target all the current unreached people groups of Cameroon with 60 Missionaries; which represents 2 for each unreached people group.
5. Encourage every member to lead one a person to Christ and disciple them to win others per year.
6. Every local church in towns and cities should labor to grow to a minimum membership of 200.
7. Have at least 100 graduates from our training systems every year and also strengthen weekend Bible schools.

**Therefore**, as a movement we agree that we will radically change the way we transact church business to enhance a revolution in the movement by critically focusing on the following:

- For pastors to regularly teach and preach on the Holy Spirit baptism (empowerment) at least once a month.
- Organize Acts 1:8 Conferences in the Local Churches, Regions and National level with Holy Spirit receiving opportunities.
- Encourage and train people to actively evangelize others (every person to win another person in a year).
- Organize short term missions to the unreached people groups of Cameroon.
- Have training for bi-vocational ministers (during the holidays)
- Every special annual regional and district program should have an emphasis of the Spirit and prayer rallies.
- Each local church should organize Pentecostal teachings and Holy Spirit receiving rallies during Pentecostal Sunday (Week).
- Deliberately have Youth training Programs to encourage bi-vocational Youth Ministers.
- Reorganize and strength the Missions department which will include an Evangelistic section.
- Mobilize Prayer from within the local church and regions for the Decade of Pentecost
