

CONFERENCE ACTS 1: 8 GABON

RESOLUTIONS

We, the participants in this conference Acts 1:8, commit ourselves and affirm our desire to lead the Assemblies of God of Gabon (AGG) to experience the revival of the Holy Spirit and the multiplication of local churches.

We pledge to make every effort to achieve the following objectives from 24th August, 2013 to December 2020:

1. Lead at least 80% of our members to be baptized in the Holy Spirit.
2. Plant across the country, 300 local churches.
3. Train 300 new servants of God and collaborators, church planters
4. Encourage each local church to take the initiative to plant at least one local church in the same period.
5. Train, send and support at least five (5) missionaries on the mission field abroad.

We also agree that the Departments of Pentecostalism and Mission, under the supervision of the National Bureau, organize and supervise the implementation of the following actions to promote the success of our goals:

1. Organize fasting and prayer meetings for the mission and the empowerment of the Holy Spirit.
2. Commitment of all servants of God, to preach on the baptism in the Holy Spirit and God's mission, at least once a month.
3. Leaders and area pastors of local churches will evangelize and plant churches.
4. Organize local and regional seminars on the basis of Acts 1:8.
5. Organize days of prayer on the baptism in the Holy Spirit at least once a term.
6. The involvement of all departments of the Assemblies of God Gabon (DEFKAD, Men, Youth, Teens and Children...) in the Decade of Pentecost and God's mission.
7. Put a particular emphasis on discipleship: Ensure that all new converts become disciples, filled with the Holy Spirit to participate in God's mission which is to evangelize our country and the world.
8. Training of Trainers.

Finally, we decide that each region and each local church establish teams of church planting, making sure that the Pentecostal fervor continues through prayers, fasting, church planting, and always remaining sensitive to the Holy Spirit at a local and national level.

May God in His grace give us His help.
