16 November 2017, Kumasi, Ghana

We, the national, regional, district and departmental leaders of the Assemblies of God, Ghana, having participated in the Decade of Pentecost Acts 1:8 conference held at Christian Village, Kumasi, Ghana on 13-16 November 2017, initiated and launched by Rev. Dr. Paul Frimpong-Manso (Ghana A/G General Superintendent), Rev. Dr. Paul Dsane (Ghana A/G Asst. General Superintendent), Rev. Dr. John B. Ghartey (Ghana A/G General Secretary) and Rev. Dr. Sam Bentil (Ghana A/G General Treasurer) do hereby, without hesitation, wholeheartedly commit ourselves and our churches to seek God for a genuine Pentecostal revival, resulting in the greatest evangelism, church planting, and missionary advance in the history of the church of Ghana.


We further commit ourselves, with the help of the Holy Spirit, to strive to achieve the goals of the VISION 3000 by the end of 2019.

- Organize events for prayer and fasting for missions and Spirit empowerment.
- Encourage the regions, districts and local churches to carry out evangelism and church planting campaigns with the goal of having a church in walking distance of every community in Ghana.
- Organize Acts 1:8 conferences at regional, district and local church levels as well as for special events such as missions conferences, men's and women's ministries, youth and children's camps and conferences.
- Require the Bible Schools to conduct regular Holy Spirit and missions emphases and that Pentecostal doctrine, experience and practice be emphasized in each of our Bible school curricula.
- Encourage every Assemblies of God local church in Ghana to raise funds for church planting and missions.
- Ensure that new converts and members in new and existing churches are being disciplined, filled with the Holy Spirit and participating in God's mission to evangelize Ghana and the nations of the world.
- That every region, district and local church recommit themselves to the Africa Assemblies of God Decade of Pentecost and work closely with the national Decade of Pentecost committee to achieve its goals.
