

Africa's Unreached Ethne: The Tigre of Eritrea



Pray for the Tigre of Eritrea and Sudan

About 1.5 million Tigre live in northern Eritrea. Only .05% know Christ as Savior. Those Tigre who are nomadic raise cattle, goats, sheep, and camels. The more settled of the tribe cultivate corn, sorghum, wheat, barley, legumes, and flax. They live in round huts, usually covered with mats of woven goat or camel hair.

Although the Tigre profess to be Sunni Muslims, most practice folk Islam, a blend of Islamic and traditional ethnic beliefs including animal sacrifices and rain making rituals. The Tigre also believe in an evil spirit named Zar, who possesses people and causes accidents, illnesses, and sometimes death. They depend on shamans protect them from evil spirits. Pray that God will send Spirit-empowered missionaries to the Tigre of Eritrea (Matt. 9:38) and
