**It is a little known fact that the modern Pentecostal revival began in an humble Bible School.**

On January 1, 1901, God poured out His Spirit on forty students attending Charles Parham's Bethel Bible School in Topeka, Kansas, USA. Several were filled with the Spirit and began to speak in tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Most Pentecostal historians cite this occurrence as the beginning of the modern Pentecostal movement. Today more than 750 million Pentecostal believers in every country of the world are serving the Lord of the Harvest.

This month we will ask God to do it again—this time in Africa. We will join together in prayer that a holy fire will be ignited in our African Bible Schools that will sweep across the continent and to the nations of the world. At present more than 14,000 students attend 250 Assemblies of God Bible Schools across Africa.

### Africa's Unreached Ethne: The Anufo of Togo and Ghana



Only about 1% of the Anufo know Christ as Savior.

About 150,000 Anufo people live in northern Togo and northeastern Ghana. Their primary means of livelihood is subsistence farming. Open air markets held every six days serve as places of business and social interaction. While about 75% are Islamic, virtually all are involved in some form of witchcraft. Only about 1% of the Anufo know Christ as Savior.

**Pray** that God will powerfully pour out His Spirit on the Anufo.

**Pray** that their hearts will open up to the message of the gospel.

**Pray** for the Togo Assemblies of God and the Ghana Assemblies of God, that God will anoint these great churches to reach the Anufo with the life-changing gospel of Christ.
