In Acts 1:8 Conferences across the continent, national AG churches have committed themselves to planting 49,612 new Spirit-empowered churches and engaging 208 formerly unreached people groups. This is part of their Decade of Pentecost emphasis from 2010 through 2020. To reach these ambitious goals, churches will need recruit, equip, and deploy a vast army of evangelists, church planters, and cross-cultural missionaries.

Some national churches already have effective mobilization programs. Others continue to develop their strategies. This month we will ask God to guide and inspire Africa's leaders as they mobilize their churches to fulfill Christ's mission in Africa and beyond.

Africa's Unreached Ethne: The Anufo of West Africa



Anufo woman. Only 2% of the Anufo know Christ as Savior.

About 200,000 Anufo (Chakossi) live in northern Ghana, Benin, and Togo. They practice Islam along with their traditional African religion, which venerates ancestors and seeks to pacify and manipulate spirits. According to the Joshua Project only 2% of the Anufo profess faith in Christ.

Pray that God will pour His Spirit on the Anufo of West Africa.

Pray for open doors and open hearts among the Anufo, that they will favorably respond to the gospel.

Pray for the Assemblies of God churches of West Africa that they will send missionaries to the Anufo.

Pray that vibrant Spirit-empowered missionary churches will emerge among the Anufo.
