

AIA Publishes New Strategic Resources


The Acts in Africa Initiative is working with AG churches throughout Africa helping them mobilize for missions.

The Acts in Africa Initiative (AIA) exists to help Africa Assemblies of God churches and pastors mobilize for Spirit-empowered evangelism, church-planting, and missions.

One way AIA does this is through the production and mass distribution of missional Pentecostal resources. These resources include books, e-books, teaching and preaching aids, and much more. In recent years AIA has distributed more than 30,000 paperback books to African pastors and church leaders. Thousands more have been distributed via the internet as e-books. AIA's most distributed book is *Proclaiming Pentecost: 100 Sermon Outlines on the Power of the Holy Spirit*.



To date, AIA has distributed more than 30,000 free books to African pastors.



In the past two years, AIA has produced six new books, including, *Proclaiming Christ, Walking with the Apostles, Walking with the Holy Spirit, The New Testament Strategy of the Spirit, How to Live for God, and Encountering God's Missionary Spirit*.

The ministry is presently working on the book, *Interceding for the Nations: 100 Sermon Outlines on Missional Prayer*. They expect to publish in late fall of this year. Dr. Denny Miller, Director of the Acts in Africa Initiative, said, "We are now seeking sermon outlines." Mark R. John York Videos Available on Youtube




Dr. John V. York,

York founded Africa Theological Training Service (now Africa's Hope) in 1990 to help train ministers and missionaries during the Africa Assemblies of God "Decade of Harvest" (1990-2000). They are equally valuable for the movement's present "Decade of Pentecost" emphasis.

Ghana AG Plans Missions Conference



The Ghana Assemblies of God, led by Dr. Paul Frimpong-Manso, is boldly pursuing the Decade of Pentecost.

Led by their National Missions Department, the church has scheduled a "Ghana Missions Consultation 2018" for 4-6 July in Kumasi. The theme of the three-day conference is "For Such a Time as This: The AG Ghana Responds to the Great Commission."

During the Decade of Pentecost, the Ghana AG have committed themselves to "seek God for genuine Pentecostal revival, resulting the greatest evangelism, church planting, and missionary advance in the history of the church in Ghana." Their goals include planting 3,000 new Spirit-empowered churches by 2019.
