AIA Urges Participation in 2019 DOP Emphasis

Dr. Denny Miller, director of the Acts in Africa Initiative, has urged national and local Assemblies of God churches across Africa to embrace the 2019 Decade of Pentecost theme: “EVERY NATION. EVERY TRIBE. EVERY TONGUE. *In the Spirit’s Power, We Must Reach Them All.*”

The 2019 theme is based on Revelation 5:9 where John looks into heaven and sees redeemed people “from every tribe and language and people and nation” gathered around the throne of God. It further takes inspiration from Jesus’ promise in Acts 1:8: “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

According to Miller, “Our 2019 theme is in keeping with our Decade of Pentecost vision of ‘10 million Spirit-empowered witnesses.’” He added, “Leaders can use the theme to encourage their churches to send laborers to these neglected peoples and places.”

Dr. Miller further challenged church leaders, “During these final years of the Decade of Pentecost, it is important that every national and local Assemblies of God church in Africa assess their present progress in achieving their DOP goals. And they need to develop a strategy to complete them by the end of the decade.” (Find your National Church’s Decade of Pentecost declaration at www.decadeofpentecost.org/africa-ag-national-churches/).

During the DOP, Africa Assemblies of God churches have collectively committed themselves to sending church planters and missionaries to 222 of the more than 850 unreached tribes of Sub-Saharan Africa. They have also committed to planting 49,612 new churches and training 42,485 new pastors by the end of 2020.


