## Pray for the Difficult Places

**As we strategize to reach Africa with the gospel we must not overlook the difficult places.**

Because millions of Africans live in remote and inhospitable places, they are more difficult to reach with the gospel. Jesus, nevertheless, directed His church to take the gospel to every person (Mark 16:15), every people (Matt. 28:19), and every place on earth (Acts 1:8) before He comes again (Matt.24:14).

This month we will again focus our prayers on those precious people who live in the remote, hard-to-reach places of Africa. Because they live in dense rain forests, barren deserts, or remote mountainous regions, it will take focused planning and heroic efforts to get the gospel to them.

## Intercede for Africa's Difficult Places

**As you pray, earnestly intercede for the following:**

**Pray** that God will pour out His Spirit on the people living in the difficult-to-reach places of Africa.

**Pray** for our national Assemblies of God churches across the continent that they will each develop a Spirit-driven strategy for reaching those who live in remote and difficult places.

**Pray** to the Lord of the Harvest that he will raise up rugged pioneer missionaries willing to go to these inhospitable places to declare salvation in Christ.

**Pray** that the Spirit will empower those who go to these hard places to preach the gospel, and that He will confirm their preaching with miraculous signs.

## Africa's Unreached Ethne: The Izarguien of Morocco



About 18,000 Izarguien Arab people reside in inhospitable desert regions of Morocco and Western Sahara. Traditionally, they are nomadic camel and goat herders. They control important routes of the Saharan caravan trade. According to the Joshua Project they are 100% Sunni Muslim with no known followers of Christ. **Pray** for God to move by His Spirit on the Izarguien people opening their hearts to the message of Christ.

**Pray** that God will raise up workers from the Assemblies of God and other groups to go to the Izarguien of North Africa. **Pray** that the door will be opened for missionaries and other Christians to freely share the gospel in Morocco and other North African countries.
