Asking God for “Words and Wisdom”

Jesus promised, “I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist.”

Jesus warned that in the days just before His return, “fearful events” would occur. These events would include famines, pestilences, and intense persecution of His followers. When these things happen, He said, we should not be afraid. On the contrary, “This will result in your being witnesses.” (Luke 21:13). Jesus further promised that at such times, “I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict” (v. 15).

This month, as the African church confronts pestilence and persecution, we will ask God to pour out His Spirit on us and grant us the wisdom and courage we need to boldly proclaim His name to all.

Africa’s Unreached Ethne: The Biafada of Guinea-Bissau



About 53,000 Biafada people live in the West African country of Guinea-Bissau. In the Biafada community, men hunt, fish, and clear the land. The women gather the crops. They practice folk Islam, and mix their traditional beliefs with their Muslim religion. With no known believers, the Biafada are listed by the Joshua Project as a frontier people group. A frontier people group is a people with less than 0.1% Christians of any kind and with no evidence of a self-sustaining church movement among them.

Pray that God will graciously pour out His Spirit on the Biafada people of Guinea-Bissau, opening their hearts to the message of Christ.

Pray against controlling spirits that have held the Biafada people in collective captivity for centuries.

Pray for the Assemblies of God of Guinea-Bissau and neighboring countries that they will be moved by the Holy Spirit to plant churches among the Biafada.

Pray that during these remaining months of the Decade of Pentecost, many Biafada people will come to know Christ as Savior.
