We, the delegates, pastors, and leadership of the Rwanda Pentecostal Assemblies of God, having opened up our hearts and lives to the powerful moving of the Holy Spirit at the **Acts 1:8 Conference** held in Kigali on 11-13 June 2014, do, without hesitation, wholeheartedly commit ourselves and our churches to seek God for a genuine Pentecostal revival, resulting in the greatest evangelism, church planting, and missionary advance in the history of the Rwanda church.

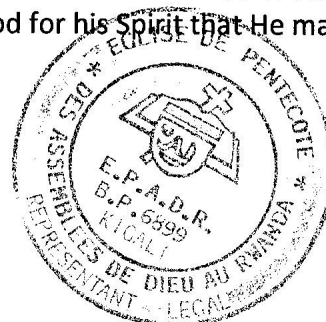
We further commit ourselves, with the help of God, to strive to achieve the following goals during the Africa Assemblies of God DECADE OF PENTECOST (2014-2024):

- 90 % of members Spirit baptized,
- 700 new churches (Spirit-empowered Churches)
- 10 home missionaries (church planters) targeting the least reached districts
- 3 Foreign Missionaries to work among unreached people groups
- 1000 new trained ministers

Further, to help us accomplish these goals, we General Executive Committee of the national church commit also initiate, promote, and direct the following Decade of Pentecost initiatives:

- Organize Acts 1: 8 conferences on all levels throughout the decade.
- Require every credentialed minister to be Spirit-baptized.
- Emphasize Spirit-baptism on all levels and in every department of the Church
- Institute Decade of Pentecost prayer groups in all local churches
- Every local Church plants a new church in every three years including those being planted
- Each local church must be sponsoring a bible school student at all times
- Each District must have a training center.
- Each local church will be required to support the bible school.
- Reconstitute and Strengthen the Missions Department
- The Bible School will conduct a Holy Spirit and a mission's emphasis each term.
- Encourage the districts, sections, and local churches to carry out evangelism and church planting campaigns.
- Institute and conduct missions training in the local churches
- Every local church emphasis Holy Spirit Baptism and missions on Day of Pentecost.

Finally, we have decided that each district, section, and local church will take what is being done by the General Presbytery and transmit them to their areas and members. Under God, we now commit ourselves and our churches to seeking God for his Spirit that He may empower us to accomplish these goals by His Grace
