National Evangelists Conference

Conducted at CCT, Morogoro, December 8-13, 2014  
(Translation by Jeff Garrett, December 14, 2014)

How will we know that the believer or the church has been filled with the power of the Holy Spirit, is in revival, and has fulfilled its mission in accordance with Acts 1:8?

Some of the Indicators are as follows:

1. The continual outpouring out of the Holy Spirit with people persevering to be filled with the Holy Spirit and speaking in tongues.
2. Real spiritual change, which is making disciples live holy lives set apart from the world.
3. Manifestations of the Holy Spirit in ministry, that is, the operation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, sermons filled with the power of God, and manifestation of the mighty acts of God.
4. A passion and a true burden for reaching sinners which results in every member giving birth to other members and doing missions inside and outside the country.
5. The church increasing numerically and geographically which is evidenced by every pastor giving birth to other pastors and churches giving birth to other churches.
6. The church being with the one aim of Christ which is gives birth to true love, fellowship, and unity.
7. The spirit of self-centeredness is broken and members are ready to serve God with their strength, their possessions, and all that they have from a loving heart and faithfully.
8. The thirst and ceaseless passion of loving services, prayers, and studying the Word of God inside of every member.
9. Regular sermons which carry the Acts 1:8 message, that is, Jesus saves, heals, died, rose again, baptizes with the Holy Spirit, and is returning again.
10. Manifestations of the power of the Holy Spirit in our praise and worship services.
11. Enough time set aside with a good balance of sermons, prayers, and intercession in our services.
12. A huge wave of people responding to the call of serving God in full-time ministry.

## What should we do to see these indicators a reality?

1. Facilitators of the Holy Spirit Conferences should set aside enough preparation time including sufficient time in prayer.
2. There should be sufficient spiritual preparation of the praise and worship groups.
3. There should be sufficient preparation of prayer in every church involved.
4. Facilitators of the Holy Spirit Conferences should prepare themselves with the message of the Word of God as in Acts 1:8.
5. Facilitators should set aside enough prayer and intercession time while conducting the conferences.
6. There should be a 3-7 day prayer camp of the Holy Spirit Conference facilitators before going to the conference centers.
7. The facilitators should encourage churches, sections, districts, and departments to combine the strength of their resources--finances, people, and time--in order to fulfill missions work inside and outside of the country.
8. The National Evangelism Department should prepare Acts 1:8 Conferences for national including evangelists and districts who have not attended this seminar before joining with a team of evangelists to conduct the conferences in the districts.
9. The Word of God (The Bible) and the book, *Proclaiming Pentecost: 100 Sermons on the Power of the Holy Spirit*, will be the special resources which will be used to conduct the conferences.
10. The Evangelism Department should prepare a manual on how to ensure the success of these conferences at all levels.

## Covenant of dedicating ourselves for conducting Acts 1:8 Conferences for the four remaining years of the Ten-Year Strategic Plan of Harvest

Considering that we have four remaining years to fulfill the Ten-year Strategic Plan, we as the Evangelism Department, national evangelists, district evangelism directors, and the team of facilitators who attended the Acts 1:8 Conference, which was held at the Christian Council of Tanzania (CCT) Morogoro, December 8-13, 2014 . . . We dedicate ourselves to fulfilling the following resolutions:

1. We will set aside enough preparation time for the Acts 1:8 Conferences, including setting up 3-7 day prayer camps before going to the conference centers.
2. We will emphasize and encourage adequate spiritual preparation of the churches' praise and worship groups.
3. We will emphasize and encourage persevering prayers of revival in every church according to Acts 1:14.
4. We will prepare ourselves to preach and teach the Acts 1:8 message, that is, Jesus saves, heals, died, rose again, baptizes in the Holy Spirit, and is returning.
5. We will conduct Acts 1:8 Conferences in all seven zones of our TAG churches.
6. We will teach and pray for the infilling of the Holy Spirit and provide feedback concerning those who were filled in every conference.
7. We will set aside enough time with a good balance of sermons, prayer, and intercession in our conferences.
8. We will motivate and encourage every member to give birth to no less than four other members.
9. We [the National Evangelism Department] will establish no less than 160 churches and motivate and encourage every church to give birth to no less than two other churches.
10. We [the National Evangelism Department] will birth no less than 160 pastors and motivate and encourage every pastor to give birth to no less than other pastors and mentor them.
11. We will preach and teach the Acts 1:8 message and motivate people to hear and respond to the call of God and then commit themselves to serve God full-time and provide feedback.

12. We will establish 80 nursery schools and motivate and encourage every pastor to start a church nursery school.

13. We will make every effort of passing on the Acts 1:8 teaching, which we received in this conference, to our fellow national and district evangelists who did not attend the conference with the objective of adding facilitators.
