Pray for New Training Initiatives in the AG

A major emphasis of the Africa AG “Decade of Pentecost” initiative is training Spirit-empowered pastors, church planters, and cross-cultural missionaries.

In response to this emphasis—and to Jesus’ mandate to “make disciples of all nations”—Africa Assemblies of God churches are establishing new training initiatives across the continent. One example of this endeavor is the new Assemblies of God Bible School that will soon be launched in The Gambia, West Africa. In this new school, The Gambia AG intends to train pastors and lay leaders to help them achieve their DOP goal of planting 100 new missionary churches by 2025. This vision is reflected in the school’s mission statement: “Training biblically-sound, Spirit-empowered servant leaders for global harvest.” This emphasis is typical of many new training initiatives in the Africa AG. This month we will pray for these new initiatives.

Africa’s Unreached Ethne: The Tsimihety of North-Central Madagascar



Only 1.74% of the Tsimihety people profess faith in Christ

About 2 million Tsimihety people live in the island nation of Madagascar. The name literally means “those who do not cut their hair” and symbolizes their refusal to submit to outside authority. They are animistic with a vague belief in a supreme being who presides over the spirit world inhabited by the spirits of their ancestors. They venerate these ancestral spirits through rituals, offerings, and adherence to a strict system of taboos. According to the Joshua Project, only 1.74% of the Tsimihety profess faith in Christ.

Pray that God will powerfully pour out His Spirit on the Tsimihety of Madagascar.

Pray that their hearts will open up to the message of the gospel.

Pray for the Madagascar Assemblies of God, that God will empower and guide this great church to reach the Tsimihety with the liberating gospel of Christ.
