

### Africa's Unreached *Ethne*: The Kotokoli (Tem) of Togo



Almost all of the Kotokoli people are Islamic

More than 400,000 Kotokoli people live in Central Togo, with about 100,000 more in the neighboring countries of Ghana and Benin. They are predominantly farmers and herdsman and known to be skilled traders. Most Kotokoli live in round mud houses with dirt floors and cone-shaped thatched roofs. These houses are clustered together in family compounds around a central courtyard. Almost all Kotokoli are Islamic, and as a result, many practice polygamy. According to the [Joshua Project](#) only 1.5% know Christ as Savior. Pray that God's Spirit will move among the Kotokoli opening their hearts to the message of the gospel. And pray for our Assemblies of God churches in West Africa that they will reach out to the Kotokoli in the power of the Spirit.


