




Across Africa women are mobilizing for the harvest

Africa’s Unreached Ethne: The Jula of Burkina Faso



More than 2 million Jula live in Western Burkina Faso. Less than .01% know Christ as Savior.

Seventy-nine people groups live in the West African country of Burkina Faso. Of those 79 groups, the Joshua Project classifies 28 as “unreached.” The largest of these groups is the Jula (also known as the Dyula) of Western Burkina Faso. Although the Jula have been engaged by the gospel, because less than .01% are saved, the tribe remains classified as unreached. For the Jula, the clan is the most important aspect of their lives. As a result they are fiercely loyal and express this loyalty through their traditions. The majority of Jula are Sunni Muslim. Others, whom the Muslims consider to be pagans, hold to traditional animistic beliefs. They represent nearly one-third of the population of Burkina Faso. Pray that God’s Spirit will move among the Jula calling them to Christ. Pray for the Burkina Faso Assemblies of God, that the Spirit will empower and guide the church as they reach out these very precious but very lost people.
