These are but three examples of 40 national AG churches who have committed themselves to aggressive church planting.

Now, with only 22 months left in the Decade of Pentecost, churches will need to redouble their efforts in order to achieve their church planting goals. This will further require a fresh outpouring of the Spirit to empower them for the task ahead. Africa's Unreached Ethne: The Baggara of Northern Cameroon



More than 3.6 million Arabic speaking Baggara people (also known as Shuwa Arabs) live in the Sahel region of West and Central Africa. About 180,000 reside in the northern tip of Cameroon. These nomadic cattle herders are virtually 100% Sunni Muslims.

Pray that God will pour out His Spirit on the Baggara people of Northern Cameroon, opening their hearts to the message of Christ.

Pray for the efforts of the Full Gospel Mission of Cameroon (an AAGA related church) and the Cameroon Assemblies of God as they

seek to reach the Baggara and other unreached people groups in Cameroon.

Pray to the Lord of the Harvest that He will send workers to the Baggara from other Assemblies of God national churches in Central and West Africa.

Pray for the safety and divine protection of Cameroonian missionaries working in the northern part of the country.
