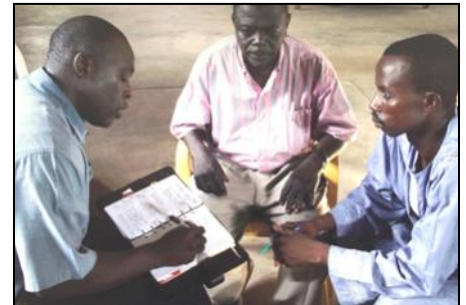
Maintaining a Spirit of Unity

Join Us in Interceding for the Following:

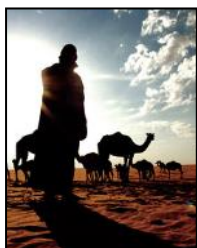
Thank God for the unity and common vision that currently exists in most of our Assemblies of God churches across Africa.

Africa's Unreached Ethne: *The Yazeed of Sudan*



About 472,000 Yazeed (or Dar Hamid) people live in the deserts of Northern Sudan. The Yazeed are a nomadic people who wander the Sudanese desert tending their camels and other livestock. They are known for their hospitality and enjoy entertaining visitors in their tent homes. The Yazeed are Sunni Muslims. The Joshua Project classifies them as a “Frontier People Group” (FPG), meaning less than 0.1% profess faith in Christ and there is no evidence of a self-sustaining gospel movement among them.

Pray that God will graciously pour out His Spirit on the Yazeed of Sudan opening their hearts to the message of Christ.

Pray against controlling spirits that have held the Yazeed people in collective captivity for centuries.

Pray to the Lord of the Harvest to send Spirit-empowered laborers to the Yazeed.
